At any given time, relief teams are responding to some 50 emergency situations around the world. Over the last 70 years, Oxfam has been involved in all the large-scale humanitarian responses.

Oxfam distributes safe drinking water, food and sanitation services in the affected areas, and strives to protect civilian populations.

The organization is also focused on risk reduction, primarily targeting poor populations with long term development programs and by tackling the underlying causes of poverty.
